



Children's Online Privacy Policy

Texasgulf Federal Credit Union is fully committed to safeguarding the personal information of our members and visitors to our website. This includes information that we may receive from children under the age of thirteen (13).

This policy explains our collection, use, and security of personal information that Texasgulf FCU may receive from a child. The Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) was passed to give parents/guardians increased control over what information is collected from children online and how such information is to be used. The law applies to websites and services directed to children under the age of thirteen (13). **Texasgulf FCU does not knowingly collect personal information from children online.**

Personal Information

Texasgulf FCU does not collect personally identifying information from our website through the use of cookies or any other tracking features.

The only personal information Texasgulf FCU will obtain is the name, address, phone number, date of birth and social security number from a parent or guardian who is attempting to open a Texasgulf Ranger Saver account and membership for any child twelve (12) or under.

Parental Consent

For contests that Texasgulf FCU hold from time to time for the Texasgulf Ranger Savers, Texasgulf FCU will obtain the name, address and phone number from all those who wish to enter. This information is never disclosed to any Third Party companies or affiliates.

The parent/guardian of the winners of any Texasgulf FCU contest must sign a media consent/release form before Texasgulf FCU will use a child's name, city, and photo in any marketing material that Texasgulf FCU produces.

Texasgulf FCU provides links to the sites of well-known, reputable companies for the use of our members for the daily use of credit union business, service providers, and important financial education.
